- Pull the pin
- Aim at the base of the fire
- Squeeze the handle
- Sweep side to side

### 4 Critical Decision-Making

- Assessing whether a fire can be safely fought
- Recognising when to evacuate instead of fight
- Understanding the limitations of portable extinguishers
- Escape route awareness while fighting fires
- When to stop fighting and leave

### 5 Hands-On Equipment Familiarisation

- The weight and handling of charged extinguishers
- Pin removal and handle operation
- Proper stance and aiming techniques
- Equipment inspection and maintenance checks

### 6 Fire Blanket Training

- When to use a fire blanket versus an extinguisher
- Proper deployment technique over stoves, appliances, and small fires
- Smothering technique and safety considerations
- Care and storage of fire blankets
- Practical deployment exercises using training equipment
